

US Export Controls Classification Information

Effective June 25, 2010, certain mass market and non-mass market encryption items became eligible for self classification under the U.S. Export Administration Regulations ("EAR") (http://www.access.gpo.gov/bis/ear/ear_data.html). As a result, Research In Motion Corporation (RIM) will no longer submit products to a classification review unless required by the EAR. RIM submitted an encryption registration in accordance with Parts 740.17(b) and 742.15(b) of the EAR. The encryption registration number for RIM is: R100005.

Please note that by RIM providing the encryption registration number, RIM is not making any representations as to your eligibility to use the encryption registration number. As the exporter, you are responsible for compliance with the EAR, and any other applicable US export laws and regulations.

Most of the BlackBerry software and all of the hardware covered by the chart may be exported under the EAR to most destinations with No License Required ("NLR"). However, these items may not be exported and re-exported to certain countries (currently Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Sudan and Syria) or to persons or entities prohibited from receiving U.S. exports, including those (a) on the Bureau of Industry and Security's Denied Parties List or Entity List, (b) on the Office of Foreign Assets Control's list of Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons, and (c) involved with missile technology, nuclear, chemical or biological weapons, or military end-uses where prohibited by an applicable arms embargo.

Please be aware that certain software applications on BlackBerry smartphones and BlackBerry PlayBook tablets may be licensed only for distribution and/or use in certain countries.
